Credit Hold Policy

The "Hold" shown on our price list is a temporary credit hold placed on your card when renting a bicycle. It covers any potential damage to the bike.

• If no damage occurs, the full hold amount is released when you return the bike.

• If repairs are needed, the cost will be deducted from the hold.

Please note: the release may take 4-7 business days to reflect in your account, depending on your bank.

Please check the bicycle for the following, if you notice anything unusual, let us know before you leave:

- Any scratches or visible damage*
- Tyres properly inflated*
- Brakes working correctly*
- Wheels turning smoothly*
- Gears shifting properly*

Emergency Evacuation Procedure

If you meet with an emergency, alert the Security Control Room on 060 536 2472/82. Report the emergency to an emergency coordinator, senior staff member or an emergency team member.

The emergency coordinator must raise the alarm by sounding the air horn. Follow an unobstructed evacuation path to the designated assembly point.

There are three assembly points for the Trail Centre:

- At the back of Picnics
- In front of the Werf Reception
- Behind the Manor House

Emergency team members (first aiders and fire fighters) must have their emergency equipment ready for the first response to the emergency.

One emergency coordinator must take a roll call at the assembly point and the rest of the coordinators and SHE representatives must monitor the site of the emergency.

Remain at the assembly point until instructed to return to your workplace.
